



CORONERSHIPS.

Applications for Coronerships for the year 1930-31 must be submitted to the Government Secretary not later than the 26th May, 1930.

By virtue of the Coroners Act, 1930, which will come into operation on the 5th July, 1930, the provision disqualifying a Coroner from holding his position in the one Sheading for two consecutive years, has been repealed, and a provision has been substituted enacting that a Coroner shall be appointed for one year only, but may be re-appointed on the expiration of such year.

Candidates must not themselves approach the Deemsters or High-Bailiffs for Testimonials, but reference respecting Candidates will be made to these officials by Government Office direct.
