His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor desires it to be made known that he has decided that in the case of future applications made to him by members of the English Bar for admission to the Manx Bar, the applicants will be required to serve articles of two years with a practising member of the Manx Bar, and to pass the Final Law Examination and the Book-keeping Examination, His Excellency reserving to himself the right to depart from this general principle in special cases.
