



## Financial Relations between the Isle of Man Government & Local Authorities.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has appointed a Commission consisting of MR. C. T. W. HUGHES-GAMES (Chairman), MR. T. B. COWLEY, MR. JOHN KELLY, M.H.K., MR. JOHN GOULDING (late Treasurer of the County Council of the East Riding of Yorkshire), and MR. A. CARSON ROBERTS (late Inspector of Audit and Technical Advisor to the Ministry of Health), to consider and report on the financial relations between the Isle of Man Revenue and the Local Authorities and Public Services, and to recommend any changes which are found to be desirable, special consideration being had to the changes recently made in English Legislation.
