ISLE OF MAN (CUSTOMS) ACT, 1927.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order (a Copy of which is appended) under Section 15 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1927, exempting from duties of Customs, Acid hydrocyanic anhydrous on importation into the Isle of Man for a period ending on the 30th day of June, 1931.

ORDER, dated the eighth day of January, 1931, made by Sir Claude Hamilton Archer Hill, K.C.S.I., C.I.E., Lieutenant Governor of the Isle of Man, under Section 15 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1927 (17 & 18 George V. Ch. 20).

WHEREAS section 15 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1927, confers power on the Lieutenant Governor, with reference to the duty imposed by Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926, to exempt from duty any article mentioned in the Order which is liable to duty under such section where he is satisfied (inter alia) that an Order has been made by the Treasury under subsection (5) of Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1926 (an Act of the Imperial Parliament) exempting the article from the duty imposed by Section 1 of the Safeguarding of Industries Act, 1921, as amended by any subsequent enactment.

AND WHEREAS by the Order made by the Lieutenant Governor (Government Circular No. 1282) the article specified in the Schedule to this Order was inter alia exempted from the duty imposed by Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926, for a period ended on the 31st December 1930.

AND WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor is satisfied as respects the article specified in the Schedule to this Order, it is inexpedient, having regard to the Order made by the Treasury under sub-section (5) of Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1926, dated the 17th day of December, 1930, that duty should be charged thereon under Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926, for the period ending on the 30th day of June, 1931, inclusive.

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the power conferred on me by the said Act DO HEREBY ORDER as follows :—

The article mentioned in the Schedule to this Order shall continue to be exempt from the duty imposed by Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926, from the expiration of the period prescribed by the above mentioned Order until the 30th day of June, 1931, inclusive.
