### **The DANGEROUS DRUGS (Consolidation) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 1931.**

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made Regulations, dated the 4th day of May, 1931, a copy of which is appended, exempting from the application of the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Regulations 1929, the five preparations containing diacetylmorphine, named in the schedule to the Regulations.

In pursuance of Section 12 of the Pharmacy and Dangerous Drugs Act, 1923, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, hereby make the following Regulations amending the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Regulations, 1928, made under that Section on the 17th December, 1929, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations :—

1. Nothing in the Principal Regulations shall apply to the preparations mentioned in the Schedule to these Regulations, and those preparations shall be added to the Third Schedule to the Principal Regulations.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Amendment Regulations, 1931.
