CENSUS OF THE ISLE OF MAN, 1931.

The provisional figures of the population of the Isle of Man as returned on the occasion of the Census taken on the night of 26th/27th April, 1931, in accordance with the Order made by His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor on the 24th February, 1931, are appended hereto.

Of the total population of 49,338, 1,494 (706 males and 788 females) were non-residents in the various Census districts of the Island. Of the 1,494 non-residents, 508 (224 males and 284 females) were persons who usually reside in the Isle of Man, but who were away from their usual addresses in the Island on Census night. The remainder of the non-residents, 986 (482 males and 504 females) were persons whose usual addresses were outside the Island.
