THE CATTLE DISEASES PREVENTION ACT.

THE SHEEP SCAB (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1931

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has issued an Order dated the 7th July, 1931 (a copy of which is appended), under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Act, 1929, providing for the licensing of sheep dippers.

On and after the 1st August, 1931, no sheep shall be deemed to have been dipped for the purposes of the Sheep Scab Order, 1928, unless the dipping has taken place in a dipper in respect of which a licence has been issued by the Government Secretary, or the Chief Clerk, Government Office.

Applications for licences for sheep dippers must be made in writing to the Government Secretary, Government Office, Isle of Man.

THE SHEEP SCAB (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1931.

By virtue of the power and authority in me in that behalf vested by the Cattle Diseases Prevention Act, 1929, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. For the purposes of the Sheep Scab Order, 1928, no sheep shall be deemed to have been dipped unless the dipping has taken place in a dipping bath contained in a dipper approved by an Inspector and in respect of which a licence has been issued by the Government Secretary or the Chief Clerk, Government Office.
2. An Inspector may for the purposes of this Order enter upon any premises and examine any dipper thereon.
3. A licence shall only be issued provided the construction of the dipper, comprising the catching pen, the receptacle for holding the dipping bath and the draining pen, meets with the approval of an Inspector.
4. A licence in respect of a dipper shall endure for a period not exceeding twelve months from the date thereof.
5. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions used therein shall have the same meanings as in the Sheep Scab Order, 1928.
6. This Order may be cited as "The Sheep Scab (Amendment) Order, 1931," and shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1931.
