ISLE OF MAN (CUSTOMS) ACT, 1927.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order (a Copy of which is appended) under Section 15 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1927, exempting from duties of Customs, certain specified dutiable articles on importation into the Isle of Man.

ORDER, dated the twenty-third day of October, 1931, made by Sir Claude Hamilton Archer Hill, K.C.S.I., C.I.E., Lieutenant Governor of the Isle of Man, under Section 15 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1927, (17 and 18 George V. Ch. 20).

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 15 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1927, that where the Lieutenant Governor is satisfied as respects any article which is liable to duty under Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926, by reason only that some ingredient or part of the article is liable to duty under that Act, that it is inexpedient, having regard to the nature of that ingredient or part and to the smallness of its value in comparison with the total value of the article, that duty should be charged under that Act, the Lieutenant Governor may by Order exempt that article from duty under the said Act.

AND WHEREAS the articles specified in the Schedule to this Order are liable to duty under Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926, by reason only that some ingredient or part of such articles is liable to duty under that Act.

AND WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor is satisfied as respects the articles specified in the said Schedule that it is inexpedient, having regard to the nature of the dutiable ingredient or part and to the smallness of its

value in comparison with the total value of the said articles, that duty should be charged under Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926.

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the power conferred on me by the said Act DO HEREBY ORDER as follows :—

Any articles mentioned in the Schedule to this Order which are not entered under the Customs Acts before the twenty-third day of October, 1931, shall be exempt from the duty imposed on the said articles by Section 13 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1926.
