



LICENSING COMMISSION.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has appointed His Honour Deemster R. D. Farrant (Chairman), Captain A. M. Spittall, J.P., and Mr. F. Mackenzie Green, C.P., J.P., to be a Commission to consider the desirability of

- (1) the abolition of redundant licensed premises ;
- (2) the curtailment of general Public House Licences, and the issue of Short Term Licences in lieu thereof ;
- (3) the restriction of retail liquor licences to premises solely used for the sale of intoxicating liquors ;
- (4) the introduction of legislation for a compensation scheme in relation to (1), analogous to the English Scheme.

Mr. W. F. Cringle of Government Office has been appointed Secretary of the Commission, and all communications for the Commission should be addressed to him.
