LEAVE OF ABSENCE OF CORONERS.

The attention of Coroners is directed to the following instruction which His Excellency the Deputy Governor has found it necessary to issue, and which must be strictly complied with in future :-

Coroners must not leave the Island without first applying to the Government Secretary for His Excellency's permission. In their applications, Coroners must state the dates within which they require leave, and set forth the arrangements they propose for the discharge of their duties during their absence.
