*A Civil Servant for this purpose is an officer, other than a Police Officer, employed in the permanent service of the Government of the Island, and whose salary is paid from the Public Revenue by the Treasurer of the Island.

Column (1).—Officers in grade (1) in receipt of basic pay of not less than £1,000 per annum are entitled to first-class railway and boat fares. Other officers in grade (1), officers in grades (2), (3) and (4) are entitled to first-class boat fare and third-class railway fare.

Column (2).—The rates specified are for a period of 24 hours' absence from home and headquarters, and must include any additional absence at the end of the period which does not of itself qualify for a day allowance.

Applications from officers for the above allowances must be made, in writing, on the prescribed form, to the Government Secretary, and be supported by the signature of the head of the officer's department.

Cabs, postages, telegrams, and all necessary outlay incidental to the special duty on which an officer is detailed to be in addition.
