



SCHEDULED MAIN ROADS.

(Tar Spraying Work).

The Highway Board has advised the Lieutenant Governor that crude tar and Foxdale Gravel are unsuitable materials for tar spraying work on scheduled main roads and that the use of such materials by Road Authorities should be discontinued.

It is notified for the information of all Road Authorities that applications for 75% and 50% grants in respect of 1st and 2nd class scheduled roads will not be approved in future unless the estimates which accompany the applications provide for the use of a tar bitumen mixture (not less than 10% bitumen) for spraying purposes with chippings (preferably granite graded $\frac{1}{2}$ in. or $\frac{3}{4}$ in.) rolled in by a steam roller.
