VISIT TO DOUGLAS.

WEDNESDAY, 15th NOVEMBER.

3 p.m. to 3-45 p.m. The members of the Town Council, of Public Bodies and of the managements of Institutions, together with Ratepayers of the Borough, will assemble in Villa Marina Hall.

4 p.m.—His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Lady Butler, attended by Lieut.-Commander A. J. Parkes, O.B.E., R.N., will arrive at Villa Marina (Main Entrance).

His Excellency will inspect the Parade of Ex-Servicemen, drawn up facing the Entrance.

His Worship the Mayor will receive His Excellency and Lady Butler, and will escort them to the platform in the Hall, where an Address of Welcome will be presented on behalf of the Ratepayers of Douglas.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor will reply.

His Worship will present to His Excellency the Aldermen, Councillors and principal Officials of the Borough.

His Excellency and Lady Butler will take tea with the Mayor and Mayoress and the Members of the Council.

NOTE.—Admission to Villa Marina will be restricted to Adult Ratepayers. Tickets can be obtained by application to the Town Clerk.

VISIT TO RAMSEY.

FRIDAY, 17th NOVEMBER.

3 p.m.—His Excellency and Lady Butler, attended by Lieut.-Commander A. J. Parkes, O.B.E., R.N., will arrive by the Ballure Road at the Court House, and will be received at the Entrance Gate by the Chairman of the Ramsey Town Commissioners and the Town Clerk, accompanied by the Second Deemster, the High-Bailiff and the Member of the House of Keys for Ramsey.

His Excellency will inspect the Parade of Ex-Servicemen, drawn up in the Court House Grounds.

The Ladies to be present on the platform will be presented to His Excellency and Lady Butler at the Entrance to the Court House.

The Chairman of the Ramsey Town Commissioners will welcome His Excellency and Lady Butler, and an Address of Welcome will be read by the Town Clerk.

WEDNESDAY, 22nd NOVEMBER.

3 p.m.—His Excellency and Lady Butler, attended by Lieut.-Commander A. J. Parkes, O.B.E., R.N., will arrive at the Centenary Hall, and will be received by the Chairman of the Peel Town Commissioners and the High-Bailiff.

His Excellency will inspect the Parade of Ex-Servicemen drawn up at the Entrance to the Centenary Hall.

Within the Hall an Address of Welcome will be presented to His Excellency by the Chairman of the Peel Town Commissioners, to which His Excellency will reply.

The High-Bailiff will express the appreciation and thanks of the Town for His Excellency's and Lady Butler's visit.
