

FLAGS ON GOVERNMENT FLAGSTAFFS.

1. On the arrival of His Excellency Sir Montagu Butler, K.C.S.I., C.B., C.I.E., C.V.O., C.B.E., on Wednesday, the 8th November, 1933, the Manx Flag will be flown from all Government Flagstaffs throughout the Island, except that at Government House, from 2.30 p.m. until sunset. The Union Flag will be hoisted at Government House as soon as His Excellency arrives at the House.
2. On the occasion of the swearing-in of His Excellency at Castle Rushen on the 9th November, 1933, the Union Flag will be flown from the Flagstaff of the Castle from the time of the arrival of His Excellency at 11.45 a.m. till sunset. The Manx Flag will be flown from all other Government Flagstaffs throughout the Island from 11.45 a.m. till sunset.
3. On the 15th November, 1933, when His Excellency pays an official visit to Douglas, the Manx Flag will be flown from all Government Flagstaffs in Douglas from 2.30 p.m. till sunset.
4. On the 17th November, 1933, when His Excellency pays an official visit to Ramsey, the Union Flag will be flown from the Court House Flagstaff from the time of His Excellency's arrival till sunset. The Manx Flag will be flown from other Government Flagstaffs in Ramsey from 2.30 p.m. till sunset.
5. On the 22nd November, 1933, when His Excellency pays an official visit to Peel, the Manx Flag will be flown from all Government Flagstaffs in Peel from 2.30 p.m. till sunset.
6. On the 24th November, 1933, when His Excellency pays an official visit to Castletown, the Union Flag will be flown from Castle Rushen Flagstaff from the time of the arrival of His Excellency till sunset. The Manx Flag will be flown from other Government Flagstaffs in Castletown from 2.30 p.m. till sunset.
