



The Import Duties (Substitution) No. 1 (Isle of Man) Order.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order (a Copy of which is appended) under Sub-section (1) of Section Thirteen of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1933, directing that in lieu of the general ad valorem duty, on the importation into this Isle of dead turkeys, a duty of one penny per lb. shall be charged.

CUSTOMS.

The Import Duties (Substitution) No 1 (Isle of Man) Order.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section thirteen of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1933, that if an Order is made by the Treasury under section sixteen of the Finance Act, 1933, directing that a duty of Customs chargeable by reference to weight or other measure of quantity shall be charged on the importation into the United Kingdom of goods of the classes and descriptions specified in the Order in lieu of the general ad valorem duty chargeable under Part I of the Import Duties Act, 1932, the Governor may by Order direct that the like duty of Customs shall be payable under the aforesaid section thirteen on the removal or importation into the Isle of Man of goods of the like classes and descriptions in lieu of the general ad valorem duty chargeable under Part I of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, and references in any enactment relating to Customs in the Isle of Man to the general ad valorem duty or the duty payable under Part I of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be deemed to include, in relation to such goods, a reference to the duty payable under the aforesaid section thirteen.

AND WHEREAS the Treasury has made an Order dated the 16th November, 1933, under section sixteen of the Finance Act, 1933, entitled the Import Duties (Substitution) No. 1 Order, 1933.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that a like Order should be made with respect to this Isle.

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue

of the powers conferred on me by section thirteen of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1933, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. As from the date of the making of this Order, there shall be charged under section thirteen of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1933, in lieu of the general ad valorem duty, on the importation into the Isle of Man of dead turkeys, a duty of one penny per lb.
2. This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Substitution) No. 1 (Isle of Man) Order.
