



Maximum Prices of Fertilisers.

Orders made by the Minister of Supply.

The Lieutenant Governor desires to announce, for the information of those concerned, that the Minister of Supply has made an Order, entitled the Control of Fertilisers (No. 2) Order, 1939, dated the 22nd December, 1939, under Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, amending the Control of Fertilisers (No. 1) Order, 1939, announced in Government Circular No. 2074.

These two Orders now provide, inter alia, for fixed maximum prices for superphosphate of lime, ground phosphate and compound fertiliser sold for delivery in the Isle of Man. The Orders do not however apply to sales of fertilisers in lots of less than one hundredweight.
