NOTICE

As to Liability for Service of Males who had attained the age of 19 years and had not attained the age of 28 years on the 1st January, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor hereby gives public notice that His Majesty has, by Proclamation made on the 1st January, 1940, directed that, with the exceptions therein specified, all Male subjects who on the date of the Proclamation had attained the age of 19 years and had not attained the age of 28 years are liable to be called up for Service in the Armed Forces of the Crown.
