**Amendment of the Food Control Committees (Registration of Establishments) Order, 1939.**

---

**Inclusion of Sugar in "Specified Foods".**

---

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939 made an Order, a copy of which is appended, providing that sugar shall be included in the "specified foods" referred to in article 1 (3) of the Food Control Committees (Registration of Establishments) Order, 1939.

The proprietors, managers or other persons responsible for the conduct of the establishments defined in the 1939 Order (i.e. hotels, boarding houses, restaurants, cafes, tea shops, coffee stalls, inns and public houses serving food, and every other place of refreshment open to the public, clubs, staff dining rooms, school feeding centres, canteens, boarding schools (providing meals for day-boarders), hospitals, sanatoria, convalescent homes, nursing homes, orphanages, workhouses, infirmaries, asylums and other similar establishments) should, if they have not already made application for registration to the Food Control Committees for the areas in which their establishments are situated, make application immediately, otherwise they will not be able to obtain supplies of sugar.

**The Food Control Committees (Registration of Establishments) Amendment Order, 1940.**

---

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939 and all other powers in me vested DO hereby Order as follows.

1. In this Order :  
"Sugar" means any sugar which has been submitted to any process rendering it suitable for human consumption, but does not include invert sugar, glucose, molasses, syrup, treacle or manufactured products containing sugar.
2. The Food Control Committees (Registration of Establishments) Order, 1939, shall be amended by inserting after the word "butter" in article 1 (3) thereof the words "and sugar".
3. This Order may be cited as "The Food Control Committees (Registration of Establishments) Amendment Order, 1940."
