



**THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS (ISLE OF MAN) 1939**  
**THE FAT CATTLE (REGULATION OF SALE)**  
**(No. 3 AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1940**

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order dated the 2nd February, 1940, (a copy of which is appended) amending the Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939.

The effect of the amendments is as follows:—

1. The prices of graded cattle are increased as under:—  
First Quality Grade— fifty-three shillings and sixpence per live hundredweight.  
Second Quality Grade— fifty shillings per live hundredweight.  
Subsidy payment, as provided for in the Cattle Subsidy Schemes, 1937 and 1939, will be paid in addition to the above prices.
2. The price of cattle authorised for allocation under Article 11 (1) of the Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1939, is increased to forty-five shillings per live hundredweight.

The Order comes into operation on the 5th February, 1940.

**The Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) (No. 3 Amendment) Order, 1940**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling DO HEREBY order as follows:

1. In the Schedule to the Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939, there shall be substituted for the words and figures "1st Quality—forty-five shillings per live cwt. 2nd Quality—forty-two shillings and sixpence per live cwt." the words and figures "1st Quality—fifty-three shillings and sixpence per live cwt. 2nd Quality—fifty shillings per live cwt."
2. In Article 11 (1) of the Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1939, there shall be substituted for the words "forty shillings" the words "forty-five shillings."
3. Article 1 of the Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1939, is hereby repealed.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) (No. 3 Amendment) Order, 1940," and shall come into force on the 5th February, 1940.
