



The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939.

The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order dated the 2nd February, 1940 (a copy of which is appended), amending the Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939.

The effect of the amendment is that the prices of fat pigs are increased as under:—

PIGS of a liveweight between 9 score lbs. and $11\frac{1}{2}$ score lbs.—twelve shillings and sixpence per score lbs. if calculated on a liveweight basis or eighteen shillings per score lbs. if calculated on a deadweight basis.

PIGS of a liveweight exceeding $11\frac{1}{2}$ score lbs.—twelve shillings per score lbs. if calculated on a liveweight basis or seventeen shillings and fourpence per score lbs. if calculated on a deadweight basis.

SWILL FED PIGS up to $8\frac{1}{2}$ score lbs. liveweight—eleven shillings and sixpence per score lbs. if calculated on a liveweight basis or sixteen shillings and sevenpence per score lbs. if calculated on a deadweight basis.

The Order comes into operation on the 2nd February, 1940.

The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1940.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO HEREBY order as follows :

1. There shall be substituted for paragraph (1) of the Schedule to the Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939, the following paragraph :—

“(1) Subject as hereinafter provided the price at which any pig for slaughter shall be sold shall be calculated upon a liveweight basis at the rate of twelve shillings and sixpence per score pounds, or upon a deadweight basis at the rate of eighteen shillings per score pounds (hereinafter called “the standard price”).”

2. This Order may be cited as “The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1940,” and shall come into force on the second day of February, 1940.
