## The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1940.

It is hereby announced, for the information of those concerned, that the Board of Trade, on the 30th January, 1940, made an Order entitled "The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1940," under sub-section (2) of Section 2 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament.

This Act was applied to the Isle of Man by His Majesty the King by Order in Council on the 16th January, 1940, and accordingly the above mentioned Order applies to the Isle of Man.

The object of the Order is to vary the list of persons, companies, trading concerns, &c., which were declared to be enemies by the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1939 (announced in Government Circular No. 2117).

A copy of the Order may be inspected by any person interested on application to Government Office.
