THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS (ISLE OF MAN) 1939.

THE ISLE OF MAN BUTTER AND BACON COMMITTEE.

IMPORTATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF LARD.

Whereas on the 30th day of December, 1939, His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor did appoint the Isle of Man Butter and Bacon Committee to import into the Isle of Man and to distribute, in accordance with instructions, bacon, ham and butter and any other foodstuffs which may from time to time be prescribed by him or on his behalf

And Whereas the Governor has now issued an Order prohibiting, except under licence, the importation into, or exportation from the Isle of Man of lard

It is now prescribed that lard shall be a foodstuff which the Isle of Man Butter and Bacon Committee is authorised, under the appointment of the 30th day of December, 1939, referred to in the first recital hereof, to import into the Isle of Man and to distribute in accordance with instructions issued by or on behalf of the Governor.
