



The Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939.

The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1940.

It is hereby announced, for the Information of those concerned, that the Board of Trade, on the 20th February, 1940, made an Order entitled "The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1940," under sub-section (2) of Section 2 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament.

This Act was applied to the Isle of Man by Order of His Majesty the King in Council on the 16th January, 1940, and accordingly the above mentioned Order applies to the Isle of Man.

The object of the Order is to vary the list of persons, companies trading concerns, &c., previously declared to be enemies by Orders of the Board of Trade under the Trading with the Enemy Act.
