THE ELECTRIC TORCHES &c. (Maximum Prices)
ORDER, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, fixing MAXIMUM prices of Electric Torches and accessories therefor, including Batteries and Bulbs.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

THE ELECTRIC TORCHES &c. (Maximum Prices) ORDER, 1940.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, acting in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939 and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO hereby Order as follows :

1. The maximum prices of electric torches and accessories therefor, including batteries and bulbs, shall be the same as the prices at which such articles were being sold on the 21st August, 1939, plus the permitted increase allowed under the provisions of an Act of Parliament entitled "The Prices of Goods Act, 1939."

2. This Order may be cited as "The Electric Torches &c. (Maximum Prices) Order, 1940" and shall come into operation as from the date hereof.
