THE SECURITIES (EXEMPTION) (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER, 1940.

The Treasury, in pursuance of their power under paragraph 1 of Regulation 5A of the Defence (Finance) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939 (which confers on the Treasury a general power to exempt securities) and of all powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order :—

1. There are hereby exempted from the provisions of Regulation 1 of the Defence (Finance) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, the securities described in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as the Securities (Exemption) (Isle of Man) Order, 1940.
