



SALVAGE OF WASTE MATERIALS.

Notice to Householders, Business Firms, Schools, Stores, Shopkeepers and Institutions.

To further the National Interests during the period of the war and to avoid waste; arrangements will be made by Local Authorities and by Boy Scout and Girl Guide organisations to collect waste paper periodically. The public are, therefore, asked to keep separate from house refuse, and to tie in bundles, which should be kept dry, any waste paper they may have from time to time, including new or old newspapers, books, journals, magazines, catalogues, cardboard, brown paper and any other clean waste paper of any kind, but **not greaseproof or carbon paper**, and hand any such bundles to Collectors.

By doing this the general public will be helping the war effort by reducing the importation from overseas of materials used for the manufacture of all kinds of paper.

If any difficulty is experienced, reference should be made to the Clerk to the Local Authority.
