THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS (ISLE OF MAN) 1939.
THE IMPORTED POTATOES (MAXIMUM PRICES) ORDER, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939 made an Order, a copy of which is appended, fixing the retail prices of potatoes imported into the Isle of Man other than potatoes grown in the United Kingdom or the Channel Islands. The Order covers the period from the 29th April, 1940, to the 15th June, 1940, both dates inclusive.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations

THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS (ISLE OF MAN) 1939.
THE IMPORTED POTATOES (MAXIMUM PRICES) ORDER, 1940.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, acting in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO hereby Order as follows :

1. No person shall sell or agree to sell or offer or expose for sale by retail or buy or agree to buy or offer to buy by retail any imported potatoes at any price exceeding the appropriate price.
2. No person shall in connection with the sale or disposition or proposed sale or disposition of any imported potatoes enter or offer to enter into any fictitious or artificial transaction or make any unreasonable charge.
3. In this Order :

"Appropriate price" means in relation to a sale by retail of imported potatoes during the several periods set out in the first column of the schedule to this Order the price set out opposite to each of such periods in the Second column of the said schedule.

"Imported potatoes" means potatoes imported into the Isle of Man other than potatoes grown in the United Kingdom or the Channel Islands.

4. This Order may be cited as "The Imported Potatoes (Maximum Prices Order 1940" and shall come into force on the 29th day of April, 1940.
