NOTICE

As to Liability for Service of Males who had attained the age of 19 years and had not attained the age of 37 years on the 9th May, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor hereby gives public notice that His Majesty has, by Proclamation made on the 9th May, 1940, directed that, with the exceptions therein specified, all Male subjects who on the date of the Proclamation had attained the age of 19 years and had not attained the age of 37 years are liable to be called up for Service in the Armed Forces of the Crown.
