



The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939. The Imported Ware Potatoes (Prices) Order, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, fixing prices of ware potatoes imported into the Isle of Man which have been grown in Great Britain, Northern Ireland or Eire.

The fixed prices are :

Wholesale	6/6d. per cwt. delivered
Retail	7/6d. per cwt. or 1/1d. per stone.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939. The Imported Ware Potatoes (Prices) Order, 1940.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, acting in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling DO hereby Order as follows :—

- 1.—No person shall sell or agree to sell or offer or expose for sale or buy or agree to buy or offer to buy at any price other than the appropriate price any ware potatoes which have been imported into the Isle of Man and which have been grown in Great Britain, Northern Ireland or Eire.
- 2.—No person shall in connection with the sale or disposition or proposed sale or disposition of any such ware potatoes enter or offer to enter into any fictitious or artificial transaction or make any unreasonable charge.
- 3.—In this Order :
“ Appropriate price ” means :
 - (1) in relation to a sale by wholesale, 6/6d. per hundredweight delivered to the purchaser ;
 - (2) in relation to a sale by retail—
 - (a) where the quantity involved is a hundredweight or a multiple of a hundredweight, 7/6d. per hundredweight ;
 - (b) where the quantity involved is less than a hundredweight, 1/1d. per stone.
- 4.—This Order may be cited as “ The Imported Ware Potatoes (Prices) Order, 1940,” and shall come into force on the date hereof.
