HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR has issued a Proclamation revoking and cancelling that issued by him on the 6th May, 1940, by which he appointed the 13th June, 1940, to be celebrated throughout the Isle of Man as a Bank Holiday in celebration of His Majesty's Birthday instead of the 14th December, 1940.

The 14th December, 1940, will thus be a Bank Holiday.

ISLE OF MAN TO WIT.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY VICE-ADMIRAL THE RIGHT HONOURABLE THE EARL GRANVILLE, C.B., D.S.O., LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE SAID ISLE, &c., &c., &c.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, by Section 5 of the Bankers' Act, 1872, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor by Proclamation from time to time, when it is made to appear to the Governor in any special case, that in any year it is inexpedient that a day by the said Act appointed for a Bank Holiday should be a Bank Holiday, to declare that such day shall not in such year be a Bank Holiday, and to appoint such other day as to the Governor may seem fit to be a Bank Holiday instead of such day, and thereupon the day so appointed by the Governor shall in such year be substituted for the day so appointed by the said Act.

AND WHEREAS the 14th December, 1940, is His Majesty's Birthday and is appointed by the said Act to be observed as a Bank Holiday in this Island.

AND WHEREAS on the 6th May, 1940, I issued a Proclamation declaring that as His Majesty had directed that His Birthday should be celebrated in 1940 at all stations both at Home and Abroad on Thursday, the 13th June instead of on the 14th December, the said 14th December, 1940, should not be a Bank Holiday throughout the Island, and the 13th June, 1940, should be observed as a Bank Holiday in its stead.

AND WHEREAS owing to the present emergency it is now inexpedient that the 13th June, 1940, should be observed as a Bank Holiday.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the power and authority in me vested, DO hereby revoke and cancel the said Proclamation issued by me on the 6th day of May, 1940.
