The Meat (RETAIL PRICES) Order (No. 4), 1940.

LAMB PRICES.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, fixing MAXIMUM prices (set out in the Order) for sale by retail of meat from LAMBS OF THE 1940 CROP sold during the period 1st. June to 31st. December, 1940.

A Retailer must exhibit clearly and in a conspicuous position inside his premises a list of the portions of lamb offered for sale and the maximum prices thereof.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

ISLE OF MAN TO WIT.

The Meat (Retail Prices) Order (No. 4), 1940.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, acting in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO HEREBY Order as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Meat (Retail Prices) Order (No. 1) 1940, the maximum prices at which meat from lambs of the 1940 crop may be sold during the period commencing on the 1st day of June, 1940, and ending on the 31st December, 1940, shall be as under:—

Legs (whole)	1/6d.	per lb.
„ (cut)	1/7d.	„ „
Shoulders	1/4d.	„ „
Loins (cut)	1/8d.	„ „
Loins (whole)	1/6d.	„ „
Chops	1/8d.	„ „
Fore Quarters	1/2d.	„ „
Neck and Breast	10d.	„ „
Under Parts	1/4d.	„ „

2. This Order may be cited as “The Meat (Retail Prices) Order (No. 4), 1940.”
