The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939.

The Production of Identity Cards Order, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order dated the 27th May, 1940, (a copy of which is appended) requiring any person in the Isle of Man responsible for the custody of an Identity Card issued under the National Registration Act, 1939, to produce such card to a Police Officer or National Registration Officer at any time when required so to do,

The Order comes into operation on the 1st June, 1940, and, as from such date, all persons must carry their Identity Cards with them. Any person who fails to produce his or her Identity Card when required to do so by a Police Officer or National Registration Officer will be liable to prosecution for a contravention of the Defence Regulations.

If any person with intent to deceive:—

- (i) makes a false representation that he or any other person is the person to whom an Identity Card relates; or
- (ii) allows any other person to have possession of an Identity Card for the custody of which he is responsible under the National Registration Regulations; or
- (iii) forges an Identity Card, or makes or has in his possession any document so closely resembling an Identity Card as to be calculated to deceive;

he will be liable to prosecution for an offence under the National Registration Act, 1939.

The Production of Identity Cards Order, 1940.

Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment or regulation at present in force, I the said Lieutenant Governor by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, Do hereby Order as follows:—

1. Any person in the Isle of Man responsible for the custody of an Identity Card issued under the National Registration Act, 1939, shall produce such card at any time when required so to do by a police officer, or National Registration Officer.
2. Any person who fails to produce his or her Identity Card as required by Article 1 hereof shall be deemed to have committed an offence against the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Production of Identity Cards Order, 1940," and shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1940.
