**The Enemy Aliens (Telephones, Telegrams and  
Wireless Apparatus Prohibition) Order, 1940.**

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, and the Aliens Restriction Act, 1922, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, providing that on and after the 14th June, 1940:—

(1) No enemy alien shall possess, use, or procure the use on the alien's behalf by another person of a telephone.

(2) No person shall permit an enemy alien to use, or use on behalf of such an alien any telephone.

(3) No enemy alien shall possess or have under his or her control any wireless apparatus, whether for transmitting or receiving.

(4) No enemy alien shall despatch or cause to be despatched on his or her behalf any telegram.

“Enemy Alien” for the purposes of the Order means a national of a state with which His Majesty is at war, and includes a stateless alien.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

**THE ENEMY ALIENS (TELEPHONES, TELEGRAMS AND WIRELESS  
APPARATUS PROHIBITION) ORDER, 1940.**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and the Aliens Restriction Act, 1922, DO hereby make the following Order :—

TELEPHONES.

1. No enemy alien shall possess a telephone.
2. No enemy alien shall use a telephone or procure the use by any other person of a telephone on such alien's behalf.
3. No person shall allow an enemy alien to use a telephone or use a telephone on behalf of an enemy alien.

TELEGRAMS.

4. No enemy alien shall despatch or cause to be despatched on his or her behalf any telegram.

WIRELESS APPARATUS.

5. No enemy alien shall have in his or her possession or under his or her control any wireless apparatus whether for transmitting or receiving.
6. "Enemy alien" shall mean a national of any state with which His Majesty is at war and shall include a stateless alien.
7. This Order shall come into force on the 14th day of June, 1940, and may be cited as "The Enemy Aliens (Telephones, Telegrams and Wireless Apparatus Prohibition) Order, 1940."
