



Isle of Man Internment Camps

Medical and Dental Facilities

1. A part time civilian medical practitioner will be allotted to each Camp. He will attend at the Camp from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. daily, and at such other hours for urgent cases on being telephoned for.
2. Two hospitals will be provided in each Camp—one a general hospital and the other an infectious diseases hospital. The Medical Officer will be in charge of these two hospitals.
3. The Medical Officer, in co-operation with the Commandant, will select prisoner nurses to staff the hospitals as required. These nurses may be paid cigarette money at the rate of 6d. per diem when employed.
4. Medicines will be provided by the chemists carrying on business in the vicinity of the Camp on the National Health Insurance basis.
5. Serious cases which require special treatment not obtainable in the Camp hospital and operation cases which cannot be dealt with in the Camp hospital will be ordered by the Medical Officer, in consultation with the Commandant, to Noble's Isle of Man Hospital, Douglas, or to Ramsey Cottage Hospital, whichever is the nearer.
6. A part time dental practitioner will be allotted to each Camp and will attend daily at 10 a.m. (Sundays excepted).
7. The part time dental practitioner will be remunerated at the rate of £250 per annum.
8. The treatment to be provided at the public expense by the dental practitioner will be for the relief of pain, only, namely extractions, dressings and fillings, where necessary, in anterior teeth.
9. Any treatment other than that specified in 8. will only be carried out at the expense of the prisoner.
10. The dental practitioner will be provided with a room in the hospital for attending to prisoners.
11. As soon as the dental practitioner has dealt with those prisoners who have reported for treatment at 10 a.m. he will be at liberty to leave the Camp.
12. Local anæsthetics and filling materials required under paragraph 8 hereof will be requisitioned through Government Office.
