

## Rushen Internment Camp.

1. Proprietors of hotels boarding houses, lodging houses, etc., who have German women billeted in their houses, must arrange that the quantity of meat consumed by German women does not exceed 4ozs. per person per day on five days a week (2ozs. for children under 6 years of age).

On the other two days, fish (fresh, salt cured or smoked) can be given up to a quantity not exceeding 80zs. per day (40zs. for children under 6 years of age). Fish should be provided on Tuesdays and Fridays.

2. Sugar must not be provided in excess of loz. per day per person billeted.
