



The Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939

The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 5) Order, 1940, and the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 6) Order, 1940.

It is hereby announced, for the information of those concerned, that the Board of Trade, on the 28th May, 1940, and the 1st June, 1940, made Orders entitled "The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 5) Order, 1940" and "The Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) (Amendment) (No. 6) Order, 1940," respectively, under sub-section (2) of Section 2 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament.

This Act was applied to the Isle of Man by Order of His Majesty the King in Council on the 16th January, 1940, and accordingly the above mentioned Orders apply to the Isle of Man.

The object of the Orders is to vary the list of persons, companies, trading concerns, etc., previously declared by the Board of Trade to be enemies under the Trading with the Enemy Act.
