**THE ALIENS RESTRICTION ORDER, 1940.**

---

---

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order under the Aliens Restriction Act, 1922, a copy of which is appended, enacting that :

- (1) Aliens shall not have in their possession or under their control or use
  - (a) any motor vehicle or bicycle ;
  - (b) any camera or other photographic apparatus ;
  - (c) any telescope, field glasses or other optical instrument ;
  - (d) any nautical chart ; or
  - (e) any sea-going craft or aircraft.
  
- (2) Aliens shall not be out of doors between 9-30 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Exemption from these restrictions may be granted by a Registration Officer to aliens who are not in internment camps.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

## *The Aliens Restriction Act, 1922*

### *THE ALIENS RESTRICTION ORDER, 1940*

---

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested under the Aliens Restriction Act, 1922, DO hereby make the following Order.

1. Subject as hereinafter provided, every alien residing in the Isle of Man shall comply with the following restrictions, that is to say :
  - (1) He or she shall not have in his or her possession or under his or her control or use any motor vehicle or any bicycle.
  - (2) He or she shall not have in his or her possession or under his or her control or use :
    - (a) any camera or other photographic apparatus ;
    - (b) any telescope, field glasses or other optical instrument ;
    - (c) any nautical chart ; or
    - (d) any sea-going craft or aircraft,
  - (3) He or she shall not be out-of-doors between the hours of 9-30 o'clock in the evening and 6 o'clock in the morning.
2. (1) Exemption from any of the foregoing restrictions may be granted in writing to an alien (except an alien in an Internment Camp) by or on behalf of a Registration Officer.
  - (2) Any exemption under this article may be granted for a specified period and subject to conditions, and may be cancelled or varied by the Registration Officer by whom it is granted.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Aliens Restriction Order, 1940," and shall come into force on the 14th day of June, 1940.
