Isle of Man Internment Camps.

MEDICAL FACILITIES.

1.—Spectacles for internees will only be provided at the Government expense in the event of the internee being destitute and unable to pay, and on the Medical Officer certifying spectacles to be essential. The same procedure will apply with regard to repairs.

2.—X-ray examinations will be regarded as “special treatment” for the purposes of paragraph 5 of Government Circular 2215.
