



The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939.

The Explosives &c. (Specified Area) Order, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order, a copy of which is appended, specifying the whole of the Isle of Man as an area to which the provisions of paragraph (2) of Regulation 34 of the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939 shall apply.

The effect of the Order is to require every person keeping explosives, ammunition or firearms to comply with all such directions for securing their safe custody as may be given by the Chief Constable.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.
