**The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 4  
Amendment) Order, 1940.**

HIS EXCELLENCY the Lieutenant-Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order dated the 10th June, 1940 (a copy of which is appended) amending the Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939.

The effect of the amendment is that, as from the 17th June, 1940, the prices of fat pigs will be as follows :—

Pigs of a liveweight—	Price per score lbs. liveweight	Price per score lbs. deadweight
between 8 score lbs. and 13 score lbs. ....	13/4 ...	19/-
between 13 score 1 lb. and 15 score lbs. ....	12/6 ...	18/-
between 15 score 1 lb. and 16 score lbs. ....	11/3 ...	16/-
exceeding 16 score lbs. ....	10/6 ...	15/-
Swill fed pigs up to 8½ score lbs. liveweight .....	11/6 ...	16/7

**The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 4  
Amendment) Order, 1940.**

I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows :—

1. There shall be substituted for the Schedule to the Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939, the following Schedule :—

SCHEDULE

Pigs of a liveweight—	Price per score lbs. liveweight	Price per score lbs. deadweight
between 8 score lbs. and 13 score lbs. ....	13/4 ...	19/-
between 13 score 1 lb. and 15 score lbs. ....	12/6 ...	18/-
between 15 score 1 lb. and 16 score lbs. ....	11/3 ...	16/-
exceeding 16 score lbs. ....	10/6 ...	15/-
Swill fed pigs up to 8½ score lbs. liveweight .....	11/6 ...	16/7

Where in the case of a pig sold on a deadweight basis, the dressed carcase as hereinbefore defined or any part of such carcase is condemned under any statutory authority as being unfit for human consumption there shall be deducted from the deadweight of such pig for the purpose of calculating the price thereof a weight corresponding to the weight of any part of such carcase that is so condemned.

2. The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1940, is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as “The Fat Pigs (Regulation of Sale) (No. 4 Amendment) Order, 1940,” and shall come into operation on the 17th day of June, 1940.
