



ISLE OF MAN INTERNMENT CAMPS.

Route Marching and Bathing Facilities.

Provided the necessary escorts can be found, there is no objection to internees being exercised by means of route marches, especially in the case of the more congested Camps, where playing field accommodation is restricted.

Internees may also be permitted to bathe, subject to the following conditions :—

- (1) The necessary escort can be found.
- (2) The bathing takes place immediately opposite the Camp and nowhere else.
- (3) All internees attending bathing parades wear appropriate bathing costumes.
