IMPORT DUTIES (EXEMPTIONS) (No. 4)
(ISLE OF MAN) ORDER, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order (a copy of which is appended) under Section one of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, sub-section (2) of section five of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1934, and section seven of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1936, directing that the goods specified in the Schedule to such Order shall be added to the First Schedule to the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, for the period of one year beginning with the 14th day of June, 1940, and that the said Schedule as amended by the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) (Isle of Man) Order, 1936, and by subsequent Orders shall be further amended.

CUSTOMS.

THE IMPORT DUTIES (EXEMPTIONS) (No. 4) (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER, 1940.

(Rubber.)

WHEREAS the Treasury has by Order (No. 3) dated the 28th day of May, 1940, made under sections 1 and 19 of the Import Duties Act, 1932, section 10 of the Finance Act, 1934, section 7 of the Finance Act, 1936, and section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, ordered that, for a specified period, the goods specified in the Schedule to the Order shall be added to the First Schedule to the Import Duties Act, 1932, and that the said First Schedule, as amended by the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) Order, 1935, and by subsequent Orders, shall be further amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by section 1 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1934, and section 7 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1936, and of all powers enabling me in that behalf, make the following Order:—

1. (1) The goods specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be added to the First Schedule to the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, for the period of one year beginning with the date of the coming into operation of this Order.

(2) The said First Schedule as amended by the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) (Isle of Man) Order, 1936, and by subsequent Orders, shall be further amended by inserting, after sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (7) of Group X therein, as sub-paragraph (iv) of that paragraph, the words and figures contained in the Schedule to this Order, and the Second Annex to the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) (Isle of Man) Order, 1936, as amended by subsequent Orders shall be further amended in like manner.

Provided that on the expiration of the period mentioned in paragraph (1) of this Article the amendments made by the preceding provisions of this paragraph shall cease to have effect.

2. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Exemptions) (No. 4) (Isle of Man) Order, 1940.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the 14th day of June, 1940.

SCHEDULE.

Aqueous dispersions of Rubber containing not less than 45 per cent. by weight of solid material of which not less than 72 per cent. by weight is rubber and not less than 15 per cent by weight is clay and titanium dioxide together, but not including dispersions containing combined sulphur.
