



SPECIAL FOOD FOR MEDICAL CASES

The procedure for ordering special diet for Medical cases such as Internees suffering from diabetes will be as under.

1. The Medical Officer will certify such items of food as are not contained in the ordinary dietary and the Chief Storekeeper will arrange for these to be supplied by local tradesmen to the extent specified by the Medical Officer.
2. Bills in respect of these special items of food will be forwarded by the Chief Storekeeper to Government Office for payment as rendered, accompanied by the certificate of the Medical Officer.
