



ISLE OF MAN INTERNMENT CAMPS.

Maintenance, Repairs and Requisitions.

In order to clarify the position the following procedure will be adopted :—

1. The Works Foreman at each Camp is responsible to the Government Surveyor for the maintenance of Buildings, Fences, &c., and for the other duties specified in Government Circular No. 2208.

2. He will maintain at the Camp outside the Compound tools necessary for executing minor repairs as well as a small supply of necessary materials.

3. The Works Foreman will report major works necessary for execution to the Government Surveyor, Murray House, Douglas (Tel. Douglas 447. Ex. 31).

4. The Chief Storekeeper is responsible for the supplies of food at the Camp for the use of the Internees and he will requisition for these in pursuance of the instructions contained in Government Circular No. 2196.

The Chief Storekeeper is also responsible for the blankets, mattresses, towels, cooking utensils, crockery and cutlery in his Camp and he must be careful to see that there is an adequate supply of these articles so that each Internee has one mattress, 1 pillow (or bolster), two blankets, 1 towel, 1 cup (or mug), 1 knife, 1 fork, 1 large spoon and one small spoon. He must also satisfy himself that the cooking utensils are adequate to provide for the cooking for the Internees in not more than two relays.

The Chief Storekeeper will requisition Government Office for deficiencies in any of the above specified articles as they arise.
