



The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939.

The Agricultural Returns Order, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, authorising the Board of Agriculture, by notice served on the occupier or person in charge of any agricultural land or undertaking in the Isle of Man, to require him to furnish such estimates, returns or other information relating to such land or undertaking as may be specified in the notice.

The Order also provides for entry and inspection of premises.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

THE AGRICULTURAL RETURNS ORDER, 1940.

Whereas it appears to me to be necessary for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community, and expedient that this Order should be made

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Regulation 55 of the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I DO hereby Order as follows:—

1. The Board of Agriculture for the Isle of Man may, by notice served on the occupier of any agricultural land in the Isle of Man, or on the person having the management on behalf of the occupier of any such land, or on any person carrying on either on his own behalf or on behalf of any other person any agricultural undertaking, require him to make to the Board within such time, and in such form, as is specified in the notice, such estimates, returns or other information relating to such land or such undertaking as the Board may demand thereunder.
2. Any person authorised in writing by or on behalf of the Board of Agriculture for the Isle of Man may enter on and inspect any premises with a view to securing compliance with this Order or any Notice served thereunder.
3. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Agricultural Returns Order, 1940."
