



THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS (ISLE OF MAN), 1939

RESTRICTION OF RIGHTS OF WAY OVER ROADS IN JURBY

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, restricting as from the 26th June, 1940, rights of way over roads and portions of roads in the Parish of Jurby referred to in the Order and delineated on the plan attached to the Order.

The plan may be inspected on application to Government Office.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

The Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939

Restriction of Rights of Way in Jurby

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested under the Defence Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers in that behalf enabling, DO hereby make the following Order:

1. No vehicle shall halt on any of the highways or portions of highways known as the Jurby—Sartfield Road, the Sartfield—Andreas Road, the Sartfield—Sandygate Road, or the Jurby—Sandygate Road, being highways or portions of highways passing through certain premises appropriated for use in His Majesty's Service or through land adjoining such premises, such highways and portions of highways being delineated and coloured brown on the plan hereto attached.

Provided that nothing in this article shall prohibit the halting in the said highways and portions of highways of a vehicle for the purpose of delivering goods or for other legitimate business purposes.

2. No motor coach or motor omnibus engaged in the business of conveying tourists shall use the said highways or portions of highways.

Provided that nothing in this article shall prohibit the use of such highways or portions of such highways by motor omnibuses engaged in a recognized road service.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 26th day of June, 1940.
