THE DEFENCE (FINANCE) (EXPORT OF GOODS) (NO. 4) (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER, 1940, DATED JUNE 21st, 1940

The Treasury, in pursuance of their powers under paragraph (1) of Regulation 5B of the Defence (Finance) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The said Regulation 5B shall apply to the territory specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, and for the purposes of sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (1) of that Regulation, the prescribed manner of payment for goods exported to a destination in the said territory shall be the manner specified in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Finance) (Export of Goods) (No 4) (Isle of Man) Order, 1940.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-fourth day of June, 1940.
