**The Defence (Finance) (Restriction of Payments)
(No. 4) (Isle of Man) Order, 1940.**

Dated June 21, 1940.

The Treasury, in pursuance of their powers under paragraph (1) and paragraph (2) of Regulation 3C of the Defence (Finance) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. Paragraph (1) of the said Regulation 3C shall apply in relation to persons resident in the territory specified in the Schedule to this Order, and it is hereby declared that the said territory is such a territory as is mentioned in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) of the said Regulation.
2. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Finance) (Restriction of Payments) (No. 4) (Isle of Man) Order, 1940.
3. This order shall come into operation on the twenty-fourth day of June, 1940.
