ISLE OF MAN INTERNMENT CAMPS.

WORKING PARTIES.

Where parties of Internees proceed out of Camp to work on the land, an extra ration of six ounces of bread and one ounce of cheese will be issued to each worker on leaving Camp.

The Chief Storekeeper will arrange to have a supply of bread delivered to the Camp sufficient to meet the extra ration, and cheese will be requisitioned from Government Office fortnightly.

A note of the extra rations issued should be made in the Stores Book and Weekly Returns.
