



THE DEFENCE (General) REGULATIONS (Isle of Man), 1939

CLOSING OF ROADS
HUTCHINSON SQUARE DISTRICT, DOUGLAS

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order, a copy of which is appended, stopping up certain highways and rights of way in the Hutchinson Square district of the Borough of Douglas, being highways and rights of way through or adjoining land appropriated for use in His Majesty's Service, such highways and rights of way being coloured pink on the plan annexed to the Order.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS (ISLE OF MAN), 1939

CONTROL OF HIGHWAYS
HUTCHINSON SQUARE DISTRICT, DOUGLAS

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, hereby Direct that the highways or rights of way coloured pink on the plan hereto annexed, passing through certain premises in the Borough of Douglas, appropriated for use in His Majesty's Service, or through land adjoining such premises, shall be forthwith stopped up, and DO HEREBY Prohibit the exercise of any right of way, or the use of any such highways.

AND I DO HEREBY give authority to Bertram Edward Sargeant, Government Secretary, to take all such steps as appear to him to be necessary and expedient in connection with the stopping up of such highways or rights of way.
